Year 7-9	Subject	How often?	Details
	English	Weekly	Students will be given a Knowledge Organiser on the unit of work being studied in lessons. They will be asked to revise a section each week ready for a 10 question quiz in their lesson.
	Maths	Weekly	Set on Sparx Maths weekly: Year 7 – 30 minute, Year 8 – 40 minutes, Year 9 – 50 minutes
	Science	Weekly	Quiz set on Satchel:One based on current topic. Knowledge organizer can be used to support with the quiz. Students can re-attempt the quiz up to 2 further times to improve their score.
	Languages	Weekly	A variety of tasks relating to the current or past topics.
	History	Fortnightly	Consisting of either a task from the topic grid or revision questions.
	Geography	Every 1-2 weeks depending on the task	A task to consolidate or extend learning or revision.
	Computer Science	Termly	Usually in booklet format but can also consist of quiz style questions via SMHW. KS3 are set homework on a two-week rotary cycle, KS4 are set weekly. Year 7 and 8 – have a booklet which is a mark out of 20, usually takes about 30 mins. When the booklet is complete, homework will be an online quiz Year 9 – have a booklet which should take about half an hour
	Design & Technology	Weekly	Various tasks that will develop both skills and knowledge.
	Art	Weekly	Various tasks that will develop both skills and knowledge.
	P.E	Approximately one every term	Topic set on The Ever Learner platform. Videos and checkpoint will be allocated.
	Performance	Twice per half-term	A written task based on what is being studied in lesson.
	RS	Monthly	A creative, research style activity to compliment learning in the lesson.
